Spelling rules for forming past simple of regular verbs:

SINGULAR	I walked	I didn't walk	Did I walk ?	work - worked cry - cried spy - spied play - played fit - fitted stop - stopped live - lived dance - danced
	You walked	You didn't walk	Did you walk ?	
	He walked	He didn't walk	Did he walk ?	
	She walked	She didn't walk	Did she walk ?	
	It walked	It didn't walk	Did it walk ?	
PLURAL	We walked	We didn't walk	Did we walk ?	Can you find at least one more grammar rule with the same spelling rules? Mind the pronunciation of verbs ending in /t/ and /d/: visit - visited [vɪzɪtɪd] start - started [stɑ:tɪd] decide - decided [dɪ'saɪdɪd]
